- Minimum grade GO KYU (Full Yellow belt) with agreement from your coach, otherwise YON KYU (Full Orange belt).
- Must have both an undamaged clean white and blue judogi that meets the size regulations, and females to wear a plain white T-shirt under the gi.
- The nails of the toes and fingers must be clean and short.
- Judogi and nails may be checked at the event.
- Tie up long hair securely so it does not touch the neck.
- Must be a current financial member of a JA Inc State or Territory Association or a recognised IJF Federation.
