Judo Australia has now launched a new Coaching Accreditation Framework (CAF). This new 4 tiered CAF replaces the NCAS and has been designed to deliver effective Coaching development for all levels of Coaching in Australia.

All those existing NCAS credentialed Coaches hold their qualification and transition across to the new system until their 4year time expires.

This initial course will focus on Coach Judo level Coaches.

Assistant Coaches are welcome to attend to assist their future progression.

<u>'Coach Judo' applicants</u> need to complete the following theory components **<u>prior to attending</u>** the practical day.

- **Unline Community Coaching General Principles Course**Heads Up Online Course
- **ASADA Level 1 Anti Doping Online Education Course**
- **4** Training Session Plans for demonstration on the day

<u>All Coaches</u> also need to bring (or provide prior) the following:

- ***** Verification of current Police Check
- ***** Copy of current Senior First Aid Certificate
- **❖** Completed and verified actual coaching hours for the last 4 years
 - **❖** Lesson plan for a 10minute warm-up and cool-down
 - ❖ Lesson plan to teach a tachiwaza or newaza skill

To achieve accreditation all Coaches will need to finalise the pre-requisites AND Participate fully on the day. There will be NO exceptions. Please complete the attached application form and submit with proof that you have completed the required pre-requisites by 16th February.
